Who are the clinicians?



Dr. Ronald Caravan, Professor of Clarinet and Saxophone at Syracuse University. Dr. Caravan earned the Performer's Certificate on clarinet from the Eastman School of Music, as well as the Doctor of Musical Arts in Music Education and Master of Arts in Music Theory. Dr. Caravan has broad experience as a solo and chamber music recitalist as well as a clinician. He performs with the Syracuse

Symphony as a saxophonist and clarinetist. Caravan can be heard on Golden Crest and Dorn Productions, Ethos Recordings and Innova Recordings. As a composer, Dr. Caravan has several works published for clarinet and saxophone, and is particularly well known for his music and teaching materials dealing with unconventional sound resources on single-reed instruments.



Ed Love, Clarinet and Saxophone Artist/Teacher, Nebraska Jazz Orchestra Music Director. Ed Love has performed with numerous bands and orchestras, including the Lincoln and Omaha Symphonies, the Ak-Sar-Ben Orchestra, Opera-Omaha, the Chuck Penington Orchestra, and the Eddy Haddad Orchestra. He has appeared with many jazz greats, including Clark Terry, Doc Severinsen, Don Menza and Henry Mancini and is an often-called-upon jazz clinician, adjudicator, and guest soloist.



Dr. Christy Banks, Assistant Professor of Clarinet and Saxophone, Millersville University. Dr. Banks serves as Assistant Chair of the Music Department and teaches clarinet and saxophone. She has performed with numerous professional organizations and appeared as a soloist in Germany and Austria.



Faith Shiffer, Instructor of Clarinet and Saxophone, Elizabethtown College. Faith has performed with various regional theaters throughout Pennsylvania, Illinois, and Montana. She maintains a private teaching practice in Ephrata.



Jonathan Pinkerton, Saxophonist/Educator. Millersville Alum, Jonathan Pinkerton, is director of bands at Lower Dauphin High School. Jonathan has performed with Jamey Abersold, Chip McNeill, the Peter Duchin Orchestra and Greg Hopkins.



Jessica Lindsey, Instructor of Clarinet and Saxophone Nebraska Wesleyan University, Concordia University and Doane College. Founder of the Nebraska Clarinet Camp, Jessica also maintains a private studio and performs regularly.
